



# April Square

This square is another one for the calendar! It is very fast and easy to make and is a great way to use up some scraps.

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in 2 colors  
Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook  
Yarn needle for weaving in ends

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc=1"

**Finished Size:** 6" x 6"

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**RND 1:** With color 1: Ch4.  
Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch4.  
19 tr in ring. Join w/slst to top of ch4.

**RND 2:** Ch1. Sc in same st as slst. Sc in each of the next 3 sts. 2sc in next st. Ch3. \*2sc in next st. Sc in each of the next 3 sts. 2sc in next st. Ch3. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off color 1.

**RND 3:** Join color 2 to same st as slst. Ch4. (Tr in each of the next sc. 5tr in next ch3 sp.) \*Tr in next sc. Rep bet () once. Rep from around. Join w/slst to top of ch4.

**RND 4:** Ch1. (Sc in each of the next 8 tr. 2sc, ch2, 2sc in next tr. Sc in each of the next 2 tr.) \*Sc in next tr. Rep bet () once. Rep

from \* around. Join w/slst to ch1. Fasten off color 2.

**RND 5:** Join color 1 to same st as slst. Ch3. (Dc in each of the next 10 sc. 2dc, ch2, 2dc in next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 4 sc.) \*Dc in next sc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.
