



# Center Cross Square

This square is perfect to use as an afghan square. You would get a very dramatic look if you used one color for all squares in the afghan. Or you could use it in a smaller project such as a placemat or pillow.

## Materials Needed

Worsted weight yarn in white. Red Heart was used in the example

Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook  
yarn needle

**Yarn Thickness:** 4mm

**Gauge:** 4dc = 1"

**Finished Size:** 6¼"x6¼"

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**RND 1:** Ch4, join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch3, dc in ring. ch3. \*2dc in ring. Ch3. Rep from \* 2 times more. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 2:** Ch3. Dc in next dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in ch3 corner sp. \*Dc in next 2 dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in next ch3 corner sp. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 3:** Ch3. Dc in next dc. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in next ch3 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. \*Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in next

ch3 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 4:** Ch3. Dc in next dc. [Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in next ch3 corner sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp.] \*Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Rep bet [] once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 5:** Ch3. Dc in next dc. [Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in next ch3 corner sp. Ch2. Sk next 2 dc. Dc in each of the next

2 dc. Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp.] \*Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Rep bet [] once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 6:** Ch3. Dc in next dc. [Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. 2dc, ch3, 2dc in next ch3 corner sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. sk next ch2 sp. Dc in each of the next 2 dc. Ch2. Sk next ch2 sp.] \*Dc in each of the next 2 dc. rep bet [] once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.
