



Ribbed Can Cozy

This is just the right size for a tight fit onto a 12oz soda can. You can make it longer for taller cans by just adding a few rounds. It is fast and easy to make and is very thick. It will keep your cold can very cold!

Materials Needed

Worsted weight cotton yarn in desired color
1 plastic ring from a jug of milk
Size G/6 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook
Yarn Needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: Fits a 12 oz soda can

Skill Level: Beginner to intermediate



Instructions

RND 1: Tie yarn onto plastic ring.
Ch1. Work 28 sc in ring. Join
w/slst to first sc.

RND 2: Ch3. Dc in each sc around.
Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 3: Ch3. Fpdc around next dc.
*Bpdc around next dc. Fpdc
around next dc. Rep from *
around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

RND 4-13: Ch3. Fpdc around next
fpdc. *Bpdc around next bpdc.
Fpdc around next dc. Rep from *
around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.
