



# 8 Point Medallion Sun Catcher

This sun catcher is also small enough to be a Christmas ornament. It is fairly fast and easy to make.

## Materials Needed

Size 10 crochet cotton in white.

Size 7 steel crochet hook

3" brass ring

Size 7 steel crochet hook

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

**Yarn Thickness:** 10thread

**Gauge:** 8sc=1"

**Finished Size:** 3" diam

**Skill Level:** Beginner



## Instructions

**RND 1:** Ch6. Join w/slst to first ch to form ring. Ch5. Dc in ring, ch2, 7 times. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5.

**RND 2:** Slst into the next ch2 sp. Ch3, dc in same sp. Ch3. \*2dc in next ch2 sp, ch3. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to top of ch3.

**RND 3:** Ch5, dc, in same st as slst. (Ch5. Dc, ch2, dc in next dc.) \*Dc, ch2, dc in next dc. Rep bet () once. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to 3rd ch of ch5. Fasten off and weave end into back of work.

**Assembly:** Join thread to brass ring. Work 10 sc in ring. Dc in one of the

ch5 lps on the medallion. \*10sc in brass ring. Dc in ch5 lp of medallion. Rep from \* around. Join w/slst to first sc. Fasten off. Weave one end into back of work. Make a hanger with the other end.
