

Daisy Pincushion

This pincushion is fast and easy to make and would make a great addition to your craft tools!

Materials Needed

Worsted weight acrylic yarn in yellow. Worsted weight acrylic yarn in white. Size H/8 or 5mm aluminum crochet hook Polyester Fiber fill Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Yarn Thickness: 4mm

Gauge: 4dc = 1"

Finished Size: 4"diam **Skill Level:** Beginner

Instructions

RND 1: W/ Yellow. Ch2. 6sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 2: 2hdc in same st as slst. 2hdc in each st around. Join w/slst to top of ch2.

RND 3: Ch1. 2sc in same st as slst. Sc in next st. *2sc in next st. Sc in next st. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first sc.

RND 4: Ch2. Hdc in same st as slst. RND 6: Ch2. Hdc in each st Hdc in each of the next 2 sts. *2hdc around. Join w/slst to top of ch2.

in next st. Hdc in each of the next 2 sts. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to top of ch2. (24sts total). Fasten off and weave ends into back of work. Set aside bottom.

RND 1-4: Top: Repeat as for the bottom. At the end of round 4, do not fasten off. Just weave the starting end into the back of work.

RND 5: Ch1. Sc in each st around. Join w/slst to ch1.



RND 7: Join top to bottom by working 1 sc in each st around going through both layers. Stuff before closing. Join w/slst to first sc. Fasten off and weave ends into back of work.

RND 8: Petals: Join white in any sc. (Ch3, dc in 3rd ch from hook, ch2, slst in same ch as dc. Sk next sc.) *Slst in next sc. Rep bet () once. Rep from * around. Join w/slst to first ch of first petal.

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
